**Free Hungary Drive
Opens in London** 1941

LONDON, Sept. 27 (Reuter).
A movement to free Hungary
from Nazi domination was
launched here today under the
leadership of Count Michael Karolyi,
former Hungarian prime minister.
A central committee was
established to secure contact with
all Hungarian organizations in the
United States and South America.

Calling on his fellow countrymen
to "Rally under the sign of
victory for Britain," Karolyi
declared that the agrarian population
of Hungary was starving under
the Nazi yoke and the only
future for them was as part of
a Danubian federation.
