

## REV. ARPAD BAKAY



The Rev. Arpad Bakay, who was pastor of the old First Hungarian Evangelical and Reformed Church in Akron, O., for 37 years, died on Nov. 13. Born in Hungary, he came to Akron in 1915 and joined the church three years after it was founded. He left in 1929 to become pastor of a church in Gary, Ind., and returned 10 years later. He retired in 1963.

He was a graduate of Lancaster, Pa., Seminary and attended the University of Akron and Oberlin College.
