Dr. Domjan Dies; Once Led Revolt

Dr. Frank Domjan, who came here as a veterinarian after being a leader of the anti-Soviet uprising in Hungary in 1956, died last night at Incarnate Word Hospital. He was 59 years old.

Dr. Domjan, who suffered a stroke Saturday night, was in charge of the provisional government in the western Hungarian region around Szentgotthard during the Oct. 23-Nov. 4 upriaing.

He fled to Austria and then to the United States with his wife and five children when Soviet troops crushed the revolt. He held too degrees from the Budapest University School of Veterinary Medicine.

He lived at 256 Kenore Court, Webster Groves and was employed by the Federal Government as a veterinarian.

Surviving besides his wife, Violet, arg, & dauguier, Mrs. Erika Wisker, Washington, and three wans, Frank Jr. and Gabo Students at the Universi ty of Missouri at St. Louis, and Lazdo, a reporter for the St. Touis Bureau of United Press International.
