declared their intention to
participate in his movement

After long discussions with
State Dept. he came out with
a Manifesto - Sep 27 - 1941
and wrote several articles ^{in Hungarian} appeared
before groups and meetings
but in general his movement
seemed too slow and lifeless.

Opposition: from liberal,
radical and Jewish
groups, although one

influential Jewish group
in NY, with the New Light
congregation, after having
discussed matters with
E. decided to participate
in his movement. They state
that his stand against the so-called "3rd Jewish
Law" of 1939 entitles him to confidence of Jews.
