

Eckhardt

1923 becomes President of
the "Awakening
Magars" (to 1928)
Dec. 17-1923

"In the middle of 1923, seeing that
his right wing radicalism ~~was~~ can not
gain ground, left the Gov's
Party of Bethlen and with
Ferenc Ulain, Endre Zsibinsky,
János Zsirkay and George
Stir founded the Party of
Defenders of Race-Purity.
This party became the
most vehement opposition
to the Bethlen Govt until
in the elections of winter,
1926, was completely
annihilated. Eckhardt
himself was left without
a mandate. From
1923 his career was
characterized by strongly right
~~wing~~ radical leanings.

In 1923^{Dec. 17} he was elected
Pres. of the Awakening
Magars, and ~~when~~ ^{when} he
later

was not a member of Parliament,
this association became
its tribune almost exclusively
Jews Pres. until 1927

In 1928 became ^{executive} director of
the Revisionist League.

In 1931 became deputy
(Mikólc) and leader of
Small Farmers Party after
death of Gaston Géal.
