

## ***Hungarian Clubs Of America Pledge Their Loyalty To U. S.***

**Bela Lugosi, Group's Head, Wires Message To Voorhis  
To Be Transmitted To Administration**

Washington, Nov. 28—Representative Voorhis (Dem., Cal.) has received assurances, to be transmitted to the Administration, that the Hungarian-born Americans banded together in a group of Hungarian clubs in this country "pledge their complete loyalty" to the American Government.

This pledge was received in a telegram to Mr. Voorhis which he made public tonight. The signer is Bela Lugosi, president of the Magyar House of American Hungarian Pioneer Families.

### **Text Of Message**

This message said:

"Prompted by Hungary's recent alignment with the Axis powers, these Hungarian-born Americans greatly desire to make two points. One, that

they are in no way in sympathy with the action Hungary took; and, two, that they do not want to be grouped either collectively or individually with the peoples of the Axis group.

### **Sympathy Asked**

"They want the Government to feel that they can be counted upon with absolute trust to serve the best interests of the United States.

"It goes without saying that the Hungarian Government took the course it did because it had no choice. Hence, these Americans who know Hungary's vexing problems so well feel that Hungary is entitled to no small degree of sympathy and they hope the American Government will be as generous and understanding as it can, under the circumstances."
