

Count Paul Teleki, the then Premier of Hungary ordered the Hungarian Legation in Washington to give Eckhardt \$7,000 dollars after his arrival.

Teleki committed suicide Apr. 3, 1941 and his successor, Premier Bardossy ordered this payment to be stopped so when Eckhardt arrived in Aug., 1941, he found himself without adequate funds. This was the reason why he attacked the Bardossy Government and in his few articles written in America (especially during the first months), he demanded its removal.
