When the foregoing article of mine appeared in the Pittsburgh, Pa. weekly, "Magyarság", Tibor Kerekes, one of the secretaries of the Eckhardt movement and Secretary of the Amer. Hungarian Federation, called me on the phone and indignantly and vehemently denied that the State Dep't release would contain anything like a wish that American citizens better leave the free movements alone and give their undivided loyalty to the cause of U.S. I had a long and unpleasant conversation with him, which several times bordered on rudeness from my part because the insolent tone and manner he tried to employ.

During the conversation he told me the following : 1.) the Eckhardt movement is fully "recognized", approved and supported by the State Dep't. 2.) That the Vámbéry-Jászi group, on the contrary, is not recognized at all and not supported, and 3.) that the US government soon will prohibit any activity from part of the Vámbéry-Jászi group. So the E. movement is the ONLY officially recognized one.

When I told him that I don't believe these assertions and I am inclined to go to the State Dept. and find out the truth for my own satisfaction, his derisive answer was: "They won't listen to you there".

He demanded that in the next issue of the paper I should write an article, "correcting" the previous one, which I denied very emphatically. My parting remark was that since according to Kerekes, I drew such impossible conclusions from the State Dep't document, I better let examine my head by an alienist.
