He was an uneducated young man in one of the mining places near Pittsburgh, Pa. (Willock) or (Bruceston) - who became involved with a group of youths in the murder of an old woman - He was sentenced to death but later this was changed to long imprisonment. His defense was that he had nothing to do with the murder, he was merely in the group of youths, doing nothing.

He spent many years in Western Penitentiary near Pittsburgh, converted by Baptists. Because of his exemplary life in prison many people worked for his freedom (Hungarian's clap) finally he was pardoned. worked steadily in Gospel work with Baptists, lives in Detroit.
