Hungarian Rebel Shot in Austria

GRAZ, Austria, June 7 (AP)—Des Zoe Fonacy, a member of the Hungarian Revolutionary Council in the anti-Russian revolt, was shot and critically wounded by two agents of Hungary's secret police here last night, police sources said today.

Fonacy toured the United States after fleeing from Hungary last fall and then returned to Europe for a lecture tour, Hungarian refugee sources said.

Red Agents Strike In Austria

GRAZ, Austria, June 8 (UP)—Agents of the Hungarian Communist A. V. H. (secret police) shot and seriously wounded a prominent Hungarian politician and robbed him of \$50,000 and some top-secret documents, the Austrian police reported today.

The police here said the victim, Beszoe Fonasy, an anti-Communist, was attacked by two Hungarians near a Groz bridge last night when he refused to turn the documents over to them.
