

FONYÓ (Fuchs) Aladár

1884-1939 Jun. 27, Hung. newspaperman



was for years editor of
the daily "Szabadság,"
after the death of
Endre Cherna, owner of
the "Szabadság" he
divorced his wife
+ married Cherna's

widow. Changed his
name to Franklin and lived
for a while in Calif. with his
second wife but soon they
divorced + F. remarried his
first wife. Became editor of
N.Y. "A. M. Népszava" and
died in 1939/27, when about
55 yrs old, in N.Y.

His widow, who was the
daughter of a piano teacher named
Sende, married Dr. Charles
Földi, staff writer of the
"A. M. Népszava"
