RUTHERFORD, N. J., April 10—Julius M. Forhecz of 1 Highfield Lane, Mayor of Rutherford, died this morning at the Columbia-Presbyterian Memorial Center, New York. His age was 48. He had been ill for two months.

Mayor Forhecz was born in Hungary and came to this country when he was 7 years old. In his youth he worked as a tool-maker's apprentice in Brooklyn and later was designer and superintendent of a machinery manufacturing plant in Scranton, Pa. In 1935, he established Park Motors here.

Elected as Mayor last November, he took office on Jan. 1 of this year. He previously had served three terms as a borough councilman and was president of the Chamber of Commerce, former chairman of the Rutherford Football Committee and a member of the Elks.

Surviving are his widow, the former Irene Kish of Buffalo; three sons, Theodore, Chris and Jerry; a daughter, Marilyn; a grandchild and two brothers, John and Joseph. The Mayor and his wife would have celebrated their twenty-fifth wedding anniversary tomorrow.
