CLARK, N. J., April 2—Julius Foris of 14 Sunset Drive, a former project engineer in the experimental department of the American Can Company in Newark, died yesterday at Muhlenberg Hospital, Plainfield. His age was 79.

Mr. Foris retired in 1950 after 25 years' service with American Can. In World War I, he was coordinator for heavy artillery at the Singer Manufacturing Company plant in Elizabeth.

He was a native of Hungary, where he received his engineering degree, and he held patents on high-speed canning processes and machinery.

Surviving are his widow, Susan; a daughter and a son.
