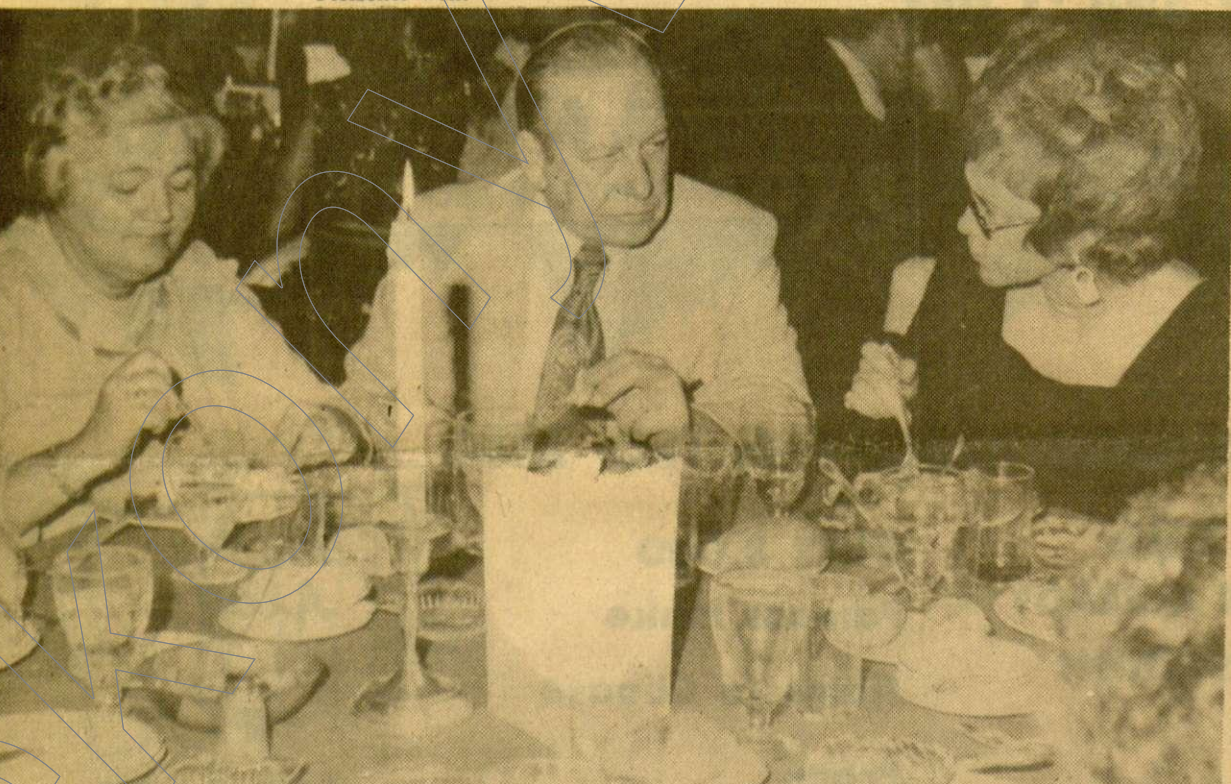
MRS. THOMAS JAWOREK, Board of Ed. President, also wished Dr. Fleischer well.
