**PLAYS FOR HUNGARIAN RELIEF**—Robert Gerle, violinist, who will be heard in joint recital with Agi Jambor, pianist, in a benefit for Hungarian relief at the Cosmos Club December 9. -1956

Mr. Gerle was born of Hungarian parents, and studied under the renowned Franz Liszt in Budapest. He also studied with such imminent personages as Geza de Kresz, Zoltan Kodaly, Leo Weiner and Imre Waldbauer while in that city and was awarded the Artist Diploma and a Hubay Prize.

In addition, he is the recipient of diplomas in the International Music Competitions held in Paris in 1946 and in Geneva the following year. He also has concertized extensive-

ly in France, Belgium, Holland and Luxembourg and was at one period staff violin soloist of the Radiodiffusion Francaise and Radio Luxembourg.

Mr. Gerle, who has appeared in presentations on the West Coast while on the music faculty of the University of Southern California, is pres-

ently Professor of Violin and Chamber Music at the Peabody Conservatory in Baltimore.
