Died Washington, D.C.  
1966 June 5. (84 yrs old)<sup>137</sup>

Minister of Hungary to U.S. after John Pelényi. Formerly Consul General in N.Y. Presented his credentials Apr. 3, 1941, the same day Prime Minister Teleki committed suicide. He informed the President that the Premier died "of natural causes".
