George Ghika, Former Hungarian Envoy Here

George S. Ghika, last minister sent to the United States by the royal Hungarian government, died Sunday at



Mr. Ghika,

under orders of Hitler and Mussolini, declared war on the United States. He was interned here at his legation residence for four months and shortly thereafter returned to Hungary.

In protest of the Nazi occupation of Hungary Mr. Ghika went to Switzerland in self-imposed exile in 1943. He moved to the United States in 1946 and had lived in Hyatts-

ville at 3900 Hamilton ave. He became an American citizen in 1951.

Mr. Ghika served nearly 40 years in the Hungarian diplomatic service and was Consul General in New York from 1926 to 1939.
