Dr. Gondos New Dean of Women at A.U.

Dr. Dorothy Ditter Gondos, associate professor of history at American University, has been promoted to the office of dean of

the women of the university, Dr. Robert V. Fletcher, chairman of the board of trustees, announces. A former Wave officer in the logistics planning section of the Navy Bureau of Ordnance and an editor of the Pennsylvania Magazine of History and Biography, Dean Gondos joined the faculty of American University in 1947.

Dean Gondos was born in Philadelphia in 1909, educated in Germantown high school, Swarthmore College, and the University of Pennsylvania, from which institution she took the degrees of master of arts and doctor of philosophy. Upon graduation from Swarthmore with Phi Beta Kappa honors and high distinction in the social sciences, Dean Gondos was awarded Swarthmore's Martha Tyson Fellowship.

Dr. Gondos began her career as a teacher of Latin, English, and civics in the Whitpain High School, Montgomery County, Pa., where she also coached dramatics and debate. Entering the university field, Dr. Gondos became assistant to Professor Leonida Dodson in the history of civilization at the University of Pennsylvania.
