"The small collection of books belonging to Arpad Haraszthy is notable from the fact that Mr. H. has made it a principle never to buy a book that he could obtain in a public library; consequently his 600 or more volumes are composed almost exclusively of rare and out of the way books, ~~selected~~ with some fine illustrated works & rare works of French authors; were these not temporarily packed away they would have afforded some interesting bibliographical notes."
