[Hadik, 41, who lived at 6912 Ayr Lane, Bethesda, was by ancestry a Hungarian count, though he did not use the title. He founded the Interna-

tional Research Group, a foreign studies group. He formerly worked for the Institute for Defense Analysis and the Bureau of National Affairs and was one of four authors of a recently published book on the strategic arms limitations talks, Maday said.

[He was once director of Coordinated Hungarian Relief.
