Boston, sülő gép lezahawas, 88 halow [One of the victims, Laszlo Hadik, was en route to Washington in the middle of a vacation from Chester, N.H., where he was visiting with his family, according to a friend, Bela Maday. [Hadik, 41, who lived at 6912 Ayr Lane, Bethesda, was by ancestry a Hungarian count, though he did not use the title. He founded the International Research Group, a foreign studies group. He formerly worked for the Institute for Defense Analysis and the Bureau of National Affairs and was one of four authors of a recently published book on the strategic arms limitations talks, Maday said. [He was once director of Coordinated Hungarian Relief. Also traveling with Hadik was Ilona de Schmertzing, a 12-year-old girl from McLean, Va. She was en route back to her parents and was visiting with the Hadik family at their Chester, N.H., home.]
