Princess Hohenlohe Registered as 'L.'



Evelyn Peyton Gordon's scoop in Tuesday's Washington Daily News that Princess Stephanie Hohenlohe was at the Wardman Park, was confirmed yesterday when it was learned she was registered as "L. de Szepessy."

The name is that of her mother, Baroness Szepessy, who is staying with her. The woman who was Hitler's confidante and who escaped deportation in Canifornia several weeks ago after she supposedly "loosened up and talked." has been at the Wardman since July 21.

The Princess born Steffi Richter in Vienna's Chetto, is pretty much in seclusion but has been seen in hotel dining rooms here by cosmopolites who knew her by sight abroad.
