Premier of Hungary since
March 10-1942 (after L. Bárdossy)

Born 1887 in Káll's sergen.

Early associate of Count Stephen
Bethlen, in 1922 Lord Lieutenant
(County Prefect of a county until 1929,
then undersecretary of Ministry of
Railways

1932 - 35 Minister of Agriculture,
deputy, belonging to no party

"well known as a liberal
politician and a close collaborator
of Count Bethlen, who opposes
the nazi regime" my Tim 1942
March 11 - 2/2
