
Even Young Eyes Can Mirror Terror

Now Eva can think of nothing but the night she and her father, Dr. Geza Kapus, and her mother fled thru the barbed wire from Red Hungary into a free zone of Austria. And she knows her mother lies critically wounded by a hand grenade thrown by a Red border guard. Dr. Kapus had been deported by the Reds to a small Hungarian town, and there held responsible for all the little things that went wrong. He took his little family across the border, but at dreadful cost.

The eyes of Eva Kapus, 6, still mirror the terror of that night. She and her father, Dr. Geza Kapus, left, a Hungarian lawyer, crossed the border to freedom in Austria by crawling thru barbed wire. Eva's mother, however, was critically wounded by a communist border guard's hand grenade.
