Death in New York of Dr. Istvan Kerpel-Fronius, son-in-law of the Venezuelan Ambassador and Mrs. Escalante, was announced yesterday by the Embassy here.

A mass will be celebrated at the Church of St. Ignatius, New York city, at noon today. Burial plans have not yet been completed.

Dr. Kerpel-Fronius is survived by the widow, former Maria Isabel Escalante, whose marriage in Paris in 1938 was a major social event, and a daughter, Anabel, age 3.

Author of several works on law, Dr. Kerpel-Fronius was an internationally known lawyer and industrialist.
