WHITEPLAINS, N. Y., May 27—Dr. Martin A. Kepes, Deputy Commissioner of the Westchester County Health Department, died of a heart attack this afternoon at his desk in the County Office Building. He was 45 years old.

Dr. Kepes was graduated from the University of Elizabeth in Hungary and practiced medicine there before World War II. Seized by the Nazis in the war, he was held in a concentration camp and after liberation was a physician for the United States Army of Occupation in Europe.
