**Widow of Former  
Hungarian Envoy  
De Koranyi, 79**

Baroness Frederic de Koranyi, 79, widow of a Hungarian diplomat, died early today at her home in Georgetown.

Her husband was Royal Hungarian minister of finance in the period following World War I, and also served as Hungarian minister to France and Spain.

Baroness de Koranyi had lived here since 1948. She made her home with her son-in-law, Edwin C. Wilson, former Ambassador to Turkey, at 3122 P street N.W. Mrs. Wilson died two years ago.

She leaves a son, Major Istvan de Koranyi, of New York; and a daughter, Mrs. William Bruce Lockling, 1529 Wisconsin avenue N.W. Services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday at Holy Trinity Catholic Church, 3514 O street N.W. Burial will be in Rock Creek Cemetery.
