July 30, 1844, New York, Mr. Gabriel D. Korponay, a Hungarian, who had lately arrived here for the purpose of teaching us the polka, went to Saratoga, N. Y., where he was received by the young with much "eclat"; and after a very successful course of teaching he visited Newport and Washington for a like purpose, and successfully.
