KENILWORTH, N. J., Oct. 5—Former Mayor Charles A. Kosmutza Sr. of 550 Kenilworth Boulevard, one time vice president of the Board of Education, died Saturday at his home of a heart attack. His age was 70.

He was an employe of the Singer Manufacturing Company plant in near-by Elizabeth for forty-three years, retiring in 1949. Mr. Kosmutza served as mayor in 1924-25, and was elected to a second term in 1934. He was secretary of the Kenilworth Library Board and a member of the local Assistance Board.

Surviving is a son, Charles A. Jr., president of the Board of Education.
