The author of the article received the picture from his father, <sup>(J. Langdon)</sup> who at the time was in Smyrna and found it at the house of a friend. To his great surprise, he found the name of his father <sup>(J. Langdon)</sup> among the 13 (4 of them arrested) to whom the picture was dedicated and who presumably received a copy of it, who helped in K's liberation.

of J. Langdon, Smyrna, June 23-  
1853 to Capt. Ingraham  
and his answer, June 24  
(To J. Langdon and the  
Americans in Smyrna),  
and the news item from the  
Smyrna French weekly (in  
translation): L'Impartial,  
8th July - 1853.

The author's father sent his  
letter from Smyrna  
April 13 - 1911. - (Author was  
at this time at Trinity  
College, Hartford, Conn.)
