NEW HAVEN, Sept. 7.—The Dwight Chapel of Yale University was the setting this afternoon for the marriage of Miss Elizabeth Josephine Kovacs, daughter of the Rev. and Mrs. Imre Kovacs of New York, to the Rev. Guilford Dudley 3d. He is a son of Mr. Dudley Jr. and Mrs. John H. Yeomans of Nashville.

The Rev. Dr. Jaroslav Jan Pelikan performed the Hungarian Reformed ceremony in English.

Mr. Kovacs escorted his daughter, who wore a gown of ivory taffeta faille and an Alençon lace veil and carried white roses and stephanotis.

Mrs. George S. Heyer and Miss Fontaine Belford were matron and maid of honor. The other attendants were Mrs. Thomas O. Pyle, Mrs. Donald Gross and the Misses Sandra Harbourt and Arlene Rubin. Robert L. Dudley was his brother's best man.

The bride was graduated last year from Hood College and attended the Yale Divinity School. Her father is minister of the First Hungarian Reformed Church of New York.
