3/8[✓]-1850 before sailing received a letter from Marsh (Minister resident in Constantinople) enclosing a summary of instructions received by him the last mail from the President of the U. S. * requesting me to remain a few days, for until after his presentation

Should the answer be favorable - the Pres. had offered the thuganians now under the surveillance of the Porte - the protection of our flag

"The Capudan Pasha, the 3rd person in govt with 2 admirals visited the ship, as also many persons of distinction - all expressed great gratification that so fine a ship had been sent with our minister
