The quotation Wilson's book says:

"When the Hungarian patriot, Kossuth came to the United States he found a responsible soul in William T. Corgshell (sic) at one time editor of the Ohio State Journal, but who died of rever when U.S. Minister to Ecuador (Mr. Cogshell toured the country with Kossuth and INTRODUCED HIM in Kentucky to James F. Robinson, a slave holder ...and in Illinois TO ABRAHAM LINCOLN...
