"While Germany was fighting to obtain freedom and unity in 1848-49, Russia aided Francis Joseph to re-establish military despotism in his dominions. This was rendered possible by the refusal of the Magyars under Komath to treat the non-Magyar nationalities of Hungary as anything except subject peoples.

Komath in exile successfully passed himself off to American and English sympathisers as a great liberal; but it may be doubted whether any man since Robespierre did so much injury to the liberal cause. He it was who deflected the Magyar national ideal from the true Liberalism of the earlier movement to egoism and racial absolutism of the present day Magyar oligarchy."
