Kossuth employed him first as a servant

through the influence of Mazzini,
he became secretary to K
accompanied him to the U. S.

After the coup d'état of Louis
Napoleon? returned to London
where he worked with Mazzini
& Ledru Rollin

(The book says that Libényi - not
mentioning his name - who in 1853 tried to
murder Emperor Franz Joseph, was a friend
of Kossuth & Lemmi)
