Dear Sir!

Henningson tells me that you will be so kind
as to help me with a loan of 10,000 \$, Fri.
day morning next.

I can scarcely see how it can be
done when I have left, but still I will
trust to your kind assurance, and would
request you, to pay to a certain Mr
Lorody, who will come to you with a slip
of paper in his hands, where you will
find written these words: "The bearer
is Mr Lorody. L P Roberts" 900 dollars
and in case of paying it to him desire
his receipt, and hand him over the adjoined
letter, the letter in case of giving him
no money, to be sent over to me to you.

Again I would desire you to pay
500 Dollars to an other man, who will
be calling at you present to you the
other half of the slip of paper here joined

The rest I being not more able to
dispose of in such a way, but requiring
to have the money in my hands to pay
off, what I have to pay here, there is no
other means left, but that you should
