At seven the Ross. meeting is
held. L. states the purpose of the
meeting and he, Trumbull and
others speak. Lincoln is appointed
to a committee of seven to draw
up resolutions. (Register)

Jan 9, Fri. - Lincoln reports
the resolutions drawn up by the
committee appointed the
previous day. They express sympathy
for the Hungarian, Irish & German
revolutionists, denounce foreign
intervention in domestic troubles
and assert that it is the right

of any people, sufficiently
numerous formation and
independence to throw off
--- their existing form of
government, and establish
such other in its stead as they
may choose. (Edith)
