THE NORTH CHURCH, FULTON STREET, 1769

New York

(Cor. of Fulton + William Sts
New York, N.Y.)
(Cromboldt)

Place of the first sung, divine service
in America 1852 March 14 - Sunday

Church 100 feet long, 70 feet wide

Cornerstone laid July 2 - 1767
by Joac Roosevelt, elder,
Chairman of Eld Committee

(one of the Collegiate Ref. Dutch
churches in N.Y.)

N.Y.'s population at that time
ab. 20,000

Dedication of Church May 25 - 1769

During Revol. War, after British
occupied N.Y., they used the church as
hospital and storage - Left NY
Nov 25 - 1783.

After restoration, church opened Dec. 1784

Again restored in 1856

building demolished in 1875,
to give place to business
buildings
