Marquess Visits Eva Bartok, Baby

KINGSTON, England, Dec. 27 (P).—The Marquess of Milford Haven spent 10 hours yeaterday at a cottage here with the Hungarian-born film aetress, Eva Bartok, and her baby.

The Marquess, who was best man at the wedding of Queen Elizabeth II, told newsmen who had spent the 10 hours waiting outside.

"Romance? Martiage? What are you talking about? I was a guest for dinner, that's all." Miss Bartok's baby, Deana Grazia, was born in a London clinic last October. She refused to name the father. She separated from her fourth husband, Austrian actor Curd Jugens, in September, 1958, and is here on a brief Christmas holiday from film-making, in Germany.

Milford Haven's name was linked to Miss Bartok's before she married Jugens in 1955. The 37-year-old nobleman was divorced by his wife the year before.
