Service Monday For Victor Bator

A memorial service will be held at 10:30 a.m. Monday in New York City's Episcopal Church of the Heavenly Rest for Victor Bator, 76-year-old Hungarian-born banker, author, publisher and teacher, who died Tuesday after a stroke suffered while attending an opera.

Mr. Bator, who maintained homes in New York and at Nonquitt, Mass., had been active as an organizer of the Free Hungary Committee in anti-Nazi and anti-Communist affairs since fleeing his native land in 1939.

His survivors include a son, Francis, who left his post as a White House assistant recently to teach political economy at Harvard University, where another son, Paul, is a law professor. A third son, Peter, is a New York lawyer.
