Auer Leopold, composer, violin vis 6. June 7-1845 - Vers d. Laschwitz, 1930 July Pupil of Josephin courts to 4.5. 1918 *Auer (ower), Leopold. 1845-Brilliant Hungarian violinist. He showed great taken for music very early, and fluring the Revolution of 1849 as a tour pear-old boy excited great enthusiasan by marching as a drummer before the troops. Studied first of the Prague Conservatory and then at the Vienna Conservatory with Dom from 1857 to 1858 and afterwards Dorn-From 1857 to 1858 and atterwards with Dackbim. Went to Düsseldorf, in 1983, as leader of the orchestra, and how 1869 to Hamburg in the same sapacity. In 1868 he went to St. Recessionry, where he still lives, as sola violinist to the Czar and in the Imperial Orchestra. On the death of Menri Wieniawski, in 1880, Auer succeeded him as profusers of violinist. eeded him as professor of violin at the Conservatory of St. Petersburg, and there, while acting as conductor of the Symphony concerts of the Imperial Musical Association he has introduced to the Russian people many important works, notably Berlioz's Requiem and Schumann's Manfred. Auer founded a quartet at St. Petersburg which became one of the leading musical organizations of the city, until it was broken by the death of Davidoff, the violoncellist.
