The picture is ^{in full regalia} a full length portrait
of Joseph Brant, a Mohawk chief,
leader of the Indians who remained
loyal to England during and after
the war of Independence and emigrated
to Canada from the U. S., settling on
the shore of the Grand River.

The picture shows considerable
artistic skill.
