

## Bishop Annabring, Born in Hungary

SUPERIOR, Wis., Aug. 28 (AP).—The Most Rev. Joseph J. Annabring, 59, Bishop of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Superior, was found dead in his home last night. He apparently had suffered a heart attack while listening to recorded classical music.

Bishop Annabring was consecrated March 25, 1954, two months after his appointment by Pope Pius XII to succeed Bishop Albert G. Meyer. The latter became Archbishop of Milwaukee and now is Archbishop of Chicago.

Bishop Annabring, a native of Szeparyliget, Hungary, spent most of his religious life in Superior. He came to the United States as a child, the family settling at Turtle Lake, Wis. He was ordained a priest May 3, 1927, in Sacred Heart Cathedral, Superior.
