Theodore Andrica, retired nationalities news writer for The Press, will be among Ohioans receiving the Governor's Award at the Ohio Newspaper Assn.'s annual dinner in Columbus Feb. 22.

Andrica is being honored by Governor Giligan for community service — for describing the history, customs and traditions of nationality groups in the Cleveland area for many years.

Others receiving awards include Pete Rose, Cincinnati Red baseball star; Hugh Downs, television personality; Arthur Schlesinger Jr., Pulitzer Prize-winning historian; Charlotte Curtis, a New York Times editor and a former Columbus Citizen-Journal staff writer; Lee Adams, music composer; Dr. Benjamin Caplan, Columbus physician; Mr. and Mrs. Al Helmut, for work with mentally retarded; Ms. Marguerite Neal, only woman appointee to the Ohio Industrial Commission, and United Auto Workers Community Action Program Council of Lima-Troy.
