## Titus de Bobula Dead; Consulting Architect

Titus de Bobula, 83, a re-  
tired architect noted for the  
many classical-style churches  
he built in Ohio and Pennsylv-  
ania, died  
yesterday at  
D. C. General  
Hospital.

Mr. de Bobu-  
la had been  
living in the  
Washington  
area for the  
last 25 years  
and was for  
many years a  
consulting ar-  
chitect here.

Before moving here, he also

designed the Belleclaire Apart-  
ments in New York City and  
the municipal center in Spring-  
field, Mass. He designed his  
own home to look like a min-  
iature castle at Spuyten Duy-  
vil-on-the-Hudson, N. Y.

Mr. de Bobula was a native  
of Budapest, Hungary, and  
was a graduate of the Univer-  
sity of Budapest.

He is survived by his wife,  
Eurana M., of the home ad-  
dress, 1830 17th st. nw.
