Our conclusions with respect to each of the individuals publicly charged by Senator McCarthy are being restated as follows:

A Esther Caukin Brunauer—
The evidence against Mrs.
Erunauer, under impartial examination, reduces itself to the fact that she was a member of one orsanization 5 years before it was cited as a Communist front, and that in 1934 and 1938, over 14 years ago, she participated in two ineetings sponsored by a proSoviet organization of which she was not a member. .. The conclusion is inescapable, on the basis of our inquiry, that there is no evidence that Mrs. Brunauer is disloyal, a Communist sympathizer or a security risk.
