Margit Bokor, 44, Dies; Former Opera Soprano

NEW YORK, Nov. 10.—Margit Bokor, 44, former leading lyric soprano at the Viennese State Opera, died yesterday at Harkness Pavilion. She was highly successful as a singer in Europe before coming to this country nine years ago.

In the United States she sang with the Metropolitan and San Francisco Opera Companies.

Her husband, Paul Goldschmidt, secretary of the Austrian Chamber of Commerce in the United States, and a daughter, Vera, survive.

MARGIT BOKOR sings the role of Steffi in *The Gypsy Baron* by Johann Strauss June 19 and 20 at the Cosmopolitan Opera House. In Vienna she used to specialize in boys' roles—Cherubino, Oberon, Oktavian, etc. Here she has appeared in light opera and one Town Hall recital. In *The Gypsy Baron* she will sing in English for the first time.
