DR. STEPHEN BOJAR

Dr. Stephen Bojar of 336 East Seventy-first Street, an agent of the New York Life Insurance Company and formerly a well-known criminal lawyer in Budapest, Hungary, died here Friday of a heart attack. His age was 68.

Born in Hungary, he received an LL.D degree from the University of Budapest. He also studied at the Sorbonne in Paris and at Columbia University. Before coming to the United States, he practiced law in Budapest, edited Cases and Masks, a law journal and wrote several law books. Dr. Bojar was former secretary of the First Hungarian Reformed Church here.

Surviving are his widow, the former Margaret Lendway, a daughter, Mrs. Edward S. Krieblich of Bronxville, N. Y., and two grandchildren.
