> Dr. Stephen Bojar of 336 East Seventy-Efft Street an agent of the New York Life Insurance Company and formerly a wellknown criminal lawyer in Budapest, Hungary, died here Friday of a heast attack. His age was 68. Born in Hungary, he received an LLD degree from the University of Budapest. He also studied at the Softonne in Paris and, at Columbia University. Before coming to the United States, he practiced law in Budapest, edited Cases and Masks, a law Journal, and wrote several law books. Dr Bojar was former secretary of the First Hungarian Reformed Church, here.
