



STEPHEN W. CSUTOROS, pastor of the Magyar Presbyterian Church of Cleveland, conducts a service in the Hungarian language at 8:45 each Sunday morning from station WADC in Akron. For five years this program has been supported financially by the members of the Magyar Church and by radio listeners in a dozen states and Canada. The staff at WADC estimates that this Hungarian program has about sixty thousand listeners. Mr. Csutoros himself has received hundreds of letters of appreciation. He has learned that in West Virginia groups of Hungarian people come together to listen to the broadcast and remain to sing Hungarian hymns and have prayers together.
